

STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

All Institutions eligible to participate in Title IV Federal Financial Aid programs must calculate and make available graduation rates and transfer out rates by July First after 150% of the normal time for completion or graduation has elapsed for all first-time, full-time students in the cohort group. These rates must be disclosed to actual and prospective students.
